ANNUAL REPORT 18-19

1. Under the joint aegis of the institution Chhotanagpur Kalyan Niketan, Simdega and CHILDLINE, villagers were made aware of prevention of human trafficking in Bagichatta Panchayat under the typical Itangangar block of the district. In this program, highlighting the ill effects of human trafficking, villagers were told that mental, physical and economic exploitation takes place in it as well as diseases that a man has to suffer. About 125 villagers (women, men) were present in this program apart from Rengarih police station in-charge.



2. The institution Chhotanagpur Kalyan Niketan organized several cultural programs in the auditorium of the institution on the occasion of Women's Day, in which about 155 women of the district participated. Outstanding performances (speech, story, poem, football, match, chair, race, etc.) were given first, second, third and consolation prizes respectively for the women who performed various activities.



3. By Chhotanagpur Kalyan Niketan, an organization, about 90 women took out a rally in Meromdega Panchayat of typical T.tangar block on the occasion of Human Rights Day to make the villagers aware that this right is equal for all rich and poor.



4. On the occasion of Environment Day, the rally was organized by the institution to protect the environment from cutting down trees to protect Raksha Bandhan and ax detainee, grazing detainee appealed to the villagers. This rally from Meromadore / Varatoli Community Building Reaching the Panchayat Secretariat office through the road, concluded about 120 women and men participated in this rally.



5. Like every year in the Simdega district, the organization celebrated the 16-day International Women's Fortnight from November 25 to December 10. This fortnight is a 16-day period in which women collectively undertake activities. In which many entertainment programs are held to challenge the gender. Under this, the band was tied by the women to the officials and employees working in all the government and non-government offices of Simdega district, which was written, "Do not say women violence". About 160 women participated in this activity.



6. With the cooperation of the organization, about 55 women, adolescent girls and victims of three blocks of district Simdega were trained in stitching and beauty parlor, art and craft, in which women made different kinds of apparel as well as designer suits. By hand and machines, the flowers (Sindhi, chainwork, cross stitch, others) were engraved, which they presented with a sample of their work and art. Crafted and made different kinds of toys.

Apart from this, women and adolescent girls are trying to improve their lifestyle by getting beauty parlor training. She is making her employment avenues by training other women at her community level as well and becoming a guide for other women as well. The victims are getting self-sufficient after getting training and are improving their condition.

7. A cleanliness drive was conducted in Kadopani village of Bolba in district Simdega with the help of the organization, in which people were told not to use plastic and what harm was caused by this project was informed by the project coordinator.

It was told by Dr. Prabhat Kumar that if an animal eats the same plastic, it can have many types of diseases. In this campaign, the support of the head, ward was received. Along with this, the villagers were urged to behave in the toilet, as well as the change of behavior was asked, they were asked not to collect garbage nearby. Pollution was also reported.

With this kind of discussion, every house of the village went and talked. About 265 women, men, children, old men and others participated in this campaign.



8 In collaboration with NABARD and the institution, 30 women were trained in mushroom farming and off-season vegetable farming, in which women were told about the types of mushroom and vegetable, planting, preparation, packing, market arrangement. The oyster mushroom was planted by women by the method of hanging, which was practiced by women. They were taken on field trips to see mushroom cultivation and unmatched vegetable cultivation elsewhere, so that the learning of women elsewhere was very effective. After training, women have started mushroom farming and off-season vegetable farming in their homes, which has seen a change in their economic status.



9. In collaboration with the institution Chhotanagpur Kalyan Niketan and Srujan Foundation, a district-level and block-level workshop was conducted to sensitize and sensitize people based on child protection programs, sponsorship and foster care under the district Simdega and Gumla. In which the chairperson of the Child Welfare Committee, Social Welfare Officer, Dalsa Secretary, Member of the Judicial Justice Board, Officers of DCPO Unit, Agnabari Sevika, Para Legal Bhelentier, Teachers, Assistants, Members of Mahila Police Station, Advocates, Non-Government Organizations, Ward Head, Block Officer, Health Sahia etc. were present, in which everyone kept their talk.



10. In association with the institution Chhotanagpur Kalyan Niketan and Srujan Foundation, awareness was given in four blocks of Simdega district by giving legal information among women and adolescents, as well as groups of men, in which they were informed about domestic violence and their types. Gaya, in which due to violence, trouble caused by identification, punishment was also told. Also gender equality was also explained. About 238 women, men, adolescents and adolescents participated in this awareness and 56 cases were seen by the institution.



11. Under the joint aegis of the Institute and Forest Department, 45 women and men were given training in farming. In which they were told about the types of lacquer and harvesting, seed planting, medicine, market system. Lakhs made from lac were also told.

The institute assessed the lac in five forest tracts of Simdega district wherein the yield of lac applied by the farmer was talked about and its market system was taken, and the questionnaire form was filled.



12. Awareness program regarding child marriage, dowry malpractices and misdemeanor was carried out in 10 villages of Meromdega Panchayat and Chhoti Bahar Panchayat of Adityaitagar block in the district. In which the problem of child marriage was explained as well as the age, law, reason, punishment, age of marriage. Pledge was also given not to do child marriage and to inform about it. Along with this, an awareness program was organized in 10 villages of Kersai Block in which the dowry illusion was also discussed, in which the incidents related to dowry were also discussed, due to which, the law, who can be punished, all these topics It was discussed.

Along with this awareness program to prevent or not to prevent feticide or to be done or not, was done in 06 villages in which a street play was done by the women, which was appreciated by the villagers, the drama told how the society Feticide is done on the basis of gender. It is everyone's job to stop such a business and how it can be stopped when it is detected.



13. Aids day awareness program was conducted by the organization, in which people present by Dr. Rajesh Kumar gave detailed information about it, its reason, prevention, treatment and taking medicine. The women participated in the foot-ball competition, all the contestants played with red ribbons and left a message to the people that the AIDS victims are also like us, do not hate them, be friends, about 69 people participated in the event.

14. Girl's Day was celebrated in 15 schools in about three districts with the help of the institution, in which girls were told about life skills as well as painting competition and cycle race competition were organized among them, in which gender equality and children's rights were given. Gone .A cultural program was organized among the children on the occasion of Children's Day in collaboration with the institution, in which the children participating were rewarded.



15. In collaboration with the institution, a rally was organized to stop child labor by the school children of Rajabasa village of Rajabasa Panchayat under the typical Itiagar block in Simdega district, in which the whole village was chanted by the children shouting slogans together. Women and men also joined in and encouraged the children, and they also raised slogans in the school premises. Was not. The total number of villagers including children was about 112 in this rally.
